Respect for your privacy is of the utmost importance to Conseil International CMI-IMC International Council, which is responsible for this website.

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to expose you:

- How your personal information is collected and processed. All information that could identify you must be considered personal information. These include your first and last name, your age, your postal address, your email address, your location or your IP address. "Personal Information" is also used as a synonym for "Personal Data" within the meaning of European Regulation 2016/679;
- What are your rights with respect to this information;
- Who is responsible for the processing of personal information collected and processed;
- To whom this information is transmitted;
- Possibly, the site's policy on cookies.

1. COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We collect the following personal information:

4. LOG FILES AND COOKIES

We collect certain information through log files and cookies. These files allow us to process statistics and traffic information, facilitate navigation and improve the service for your convenience.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (European Regulation 2016/679), for the use of cookies involving the storage and analysis of personal information, your consent is necessarily requested.

In addition, this consent is considered valid for a maximum period of thirteen (13) months. At the end of this period, we will again ask for your permission to store cookies on your hard drive.

b) Opposition to the use of cookies by the site

5. SHARING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

The personal information collected by the site is not transmitted to any third party and is only processed by us.

6. RETENTION PERIOD OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

The person responsible for the processing of personal information will keep in its computer systems of the site and under reasonable conditions of security all the personal information collected for a period of: 2 years.

8. CONTROLLER OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

b) Obligations of the Controller of Personal Information

9. RIGHT OF OPPOSITION AND WITHDRAWAL

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal information by the Site ("right to object"). You also have the right to request that your personal information no longer appear, for example, in a mailing list ("right of withdrawal").

In order to object to the processing of your personal information or request the removal of your personal information, you must follow these steps:

You may read, update, amend or request the deletion of your information by following the following procedure:

11. GENERAL PRINCIPLES FOR THE COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION UNDER EUROPEAN REGULATION 2016/679

In accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of European Regulation 2016/679, the collection and processing of your personal information complies with the following principles:

- Lawfulness, fairness and transparency: Your personal information may only be collected and processed with your consent. Whenever personal information is collected, it will be indicated that your personal information is being collected and for what purposes your personal information is being collected;
- Limited purposes: the collection and processing of personal information is carried out to meet one or more of the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy;
- Minimalization of the collection and processing of personal information: only the personal information necessary for the proper execution of the objectives pursued by the site is collected;
- Retention of personal information reduced in time: personal information is retained for a limited period of time of which you are informed;
- Integrity and confidentiality of personal information collected and processed: the person responsible for processing personal information undertakes to guarantee the integrity and confidentiality of the personal information collected.

In order to be lawful, and in accordance with the requirements of Article 6 of European Regulation 2016/679, the collection and processing of personal information may only take place if it complies with at least one of the conditions listed below:

- You have expressly consented to the processing;
- The processing is necessary for the performance of a contract;
- The processing complies with a legal obligation;
- The processing is explained by the need to safeguard your vital interests or those of another natural person;
- The processing may be explained by a necessity related to the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or which falls within the exercise of official authority;
- The processing and collection of personal information is necessary for the legitimate and private interests pursued by the controller or by a third party.

12. ADDITIONAL DUTIES UNDER EUROPEAN REGULATION 2016/679

In accordance with European regulations regarding the processing of personal information, you also have the rights listed below.

In order for the person responsible for the processing of the information to grant your request, you are required to communicate to him: your first and last name as well as your e-mail address.

The person responsible for the processing of personal information is required to respond to you within a maximum of thirty (30) days.

a) Right to portability of personal information

You have the right to request the portability of your personal information, held by the site, to another site, by complying with the following procedure:

(b) Right not to be the subject of a decision based exclusively on an automated process

In accordance with the provisions of European Regulation 2016/679, you have the right not to be subject to a decision based exclusively on an automated process if the decision produces legal effects concerning you or significantly affects you in a similar way.

(c) Right to refer the matter to the competent authority

In the event that the controller decides not to respond to your request and you wish to challenge this decision or, if you believe that it has infringed any of your rights listed above, you are entitled to appeal to any competent court.

13. SECURITY

The personal information we collect is kept in a secure environment. People working for us are required to respect the confidentiality of your information.

To ensure the security of your personal information, we use the following measures:

- Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)

- Secure Electronic Transaction (SET) protocol
- Access management - authorized person
- Access management - data subject
- Network monitoring software
- Automatic backup
- Development of a digital certificate
- Username/Password
- Firewalls

We are committed to maintaining a high degree of confidentiality by incorporating the latest technological innovations to ensure the confidentiality of your transactions. However, since no mechanism offers maximum security, some risk is always present when using the Internet to transmit personal information.

14. PERSONAL INFORMATION OF MINORS UNDER REGULATION 2016/679

In accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of Regulation 2016/679, only minors aged 15 or over may consent to the processing of their personal information.

If you are a minor under the age of 15, the consent of a legal representative will be required in order for personal information to be collected and processed.

We reserve the right to verify by any means that you are over 15 years of age, or that you have obtained the consent of a legal representative before browsing the site.
